

ARTISTIC DIRECTOR'S NOTES





"I had no idea women were playing hockey at such a high level at that time, and I was so amazed by the story of the Preston Rivulettes that I wanted more Canadians to hear it as well," says Playwright Tracey Power. The era was also exciting because swing music and dance are so vibrant and a perfect inspiration for bringing the hockey games to life on stage." Tracey has choreographed Glory's action-packed hockey games on stage to upbeat swing dance. Tracey has much experience combining her playwriting and choreography talents into critically and popular acclaim, such as with Chelsea Hotel, The Songs of Leonard Cohen and Miss Shakespeare, where she collaborated with Steven Charles.


